TECHNICAL INFO

Structure – calibrated powder coated steel tube in thermoreinforced polyester in black or white. Different base sizes available.

Table top – available in different measures, materials and thickness:

- "Sandwich" consisting in two parts, where the underneath part is always lacquered in the same colour that the base (white or black) and the top is in MDF lacquered or oak verneer finishes of our collection.

- Low Pressure Laminate (LPL) thickness 19 mm | 0.74" with 1,5 mm | 0.05" PVC edge, in white or black.

- 12 mm | 0.47" thick compact laminated table top. The edge can be in white or black. With a black edge, the surface of the tabletop can be white or black; for a white edge, it can be white.

- High Pressure Laminate (HPL) thickness 19 mm | 0.74" with 1,5 mm | 0.05" PVC edge, in white or black.

NOTE1: The height of the table varies according to the thickness of the different table tops. The height indicated below refers to the MDF table.

NOTE 2: Due to the fact that the wood used is natural, the finish may vary.
